Naval History for February

February 9

1942 While undergoing conversion at New York City pier 88, USS Lafayette (AP 53) catches fire resulting in the total loss of the ship.

1960 USS Sargo (SSN 583) becomes the third submarine to surface through the ice at the North Pole.

February 16

1944 USS Skate (SS 305) sinks the Japanese light cruiser Agano as she deploys from Truk, Caroline Islands.

1945 PB4Y-1 Liberators from (VPB 117) sink Japanese army cargo ship Ida Maru at Cape St. Jacques, French Indochina.

February 23

1919 The first ship named for an enlisted man, USS Osmond Ingram (DD 255), is launched.

1945 Four days after landing on Iwo Jima, an invasion where uncommon valor was a common virtue, the United States flag is raised on Mt. Suribachi.
